



## Uniform Clothing

1. Boys are expected to ensure that their dress and appearance bring credit to the School and themselves.
2. There is a formal School uniform, and a separate uniform for summer (as well as sport and physical education). These are listed below.
3. **The formal School uniform is also the winter School uniform.** Boys are required to wear their blazers to and from School whenever the formal School uniform is worn. Boys may wear the School pullover as well, but not instead of, the navy blazer. Boys may take off their blazer whilst at School. Lockers have hooks so the blazer may be hung up.

At other times boys are expected to wear the appropriate School uniform while travelling to and from School and School functions unless informed to the contrary.

4. Extremes of hairstyle and hair colour are not permitted. Boys are expected to have well-groomed, clean hair. It must not pose a safety hazard to themselves or others in School activities and facilities such as workshops and laboratories. Boys should be clean shaven at all times.
5. **Jewellery is not to be worn. This includes piercings of any type including clear plastic retainers used to keep piercings open.**
6. Practical guidelines for boys and parents are issued by Heads of Houses from time to time.

### **Formal Uniform (and Winter Uniform):**

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School Blazer (with House braid)

College grey trousers

Black belt

School pullover

White shirt

School tie (or Year 12 tie)

School socks

Black shoes\*

### **Summer Uniform:**

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Navy shorts

(School summer-weight long navy trousers are an option for Years 10, 11 and 12)

Black or navy belt

School striped shirt

School socks

School pullover

Black shoes\*

\* These must be polishable lace-up black shoes (not boots or sport shoes).

### **Sport and P.E.:**

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School tracksuit (top and pants)

School polo shirt (gold with navy stripe, collar, crest)

Navy PE shorts

White sport socks

House polo shirt

House long sleeved top

School racing bathers

Sports shoes (predominately white)

Navy school hat

### **Notes**

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1. The School Tracksuit Top (Navy and Gold hoop Top) can be worn when travelling to matches and as the warm and dry top after matches. It may also be used in the same way on training days but is NOT a training or playing top.
2. The House Winter Top is worn for House competitions during the year. It is also worn as a training top for winter sport.
3. All boys are involved in Physical Education classes. The boys are required to wear: navy blue shorts, School polo shirt, navy hat, white socks and sports shoes (predominately white). School racing bathers are required when swimming.
4. The School Polo Shirt is the playing top for most sports and Physical Education.
5. Navy blue sports shorts are available in three styles:  
"Football" - relatively tight fitting made from two-way stretch material.  
"Rugby" - loose fitting, strong material, with pocket.  
"Athletic"- loose fitting with splits for running  
"Lightweight" - loose fitting, made from lightweight, crushable material.
6. The Rugby playing top, navy with gold bands, is to be worn by all Rugby players in the Secondary School. It is also the top for Sailing (and will be phased in as the Winter playing top for the Preparatory School).
7. Protection from the Sun
  - (i) Hats: Two types of hats are available at the Clothing Service, and they should be the only hats worn by boys at the School. The hats are a wide brimmed hat with the School Crest, and a navy cap. One of the two types

of hats is to be worn for all outdoor sports and Physical Education in summer.

- (ii) Sunscreen lotion: Boys are encouraged to bring their own sunscreen lotion. However, sunscreen lotion is available at the P.E. Centre and is included in the kits for summer games.
  - (iii) In the swimming pool boys are encouraged to wear rash tops.
8. The uniforms are available from the School Clothing Service, and staff are happy to answer any questions.

### **Sports Uniform for Training**

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All boys are expected to be neatly attired in the match or House sports uniform. Correct footwear must be worn.

### **Sports Uniform When Travelling**

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When travelling to or from training or matches boys must wear either:

The School Uniform

or: School tracksuit top

During summer, boys may be permitted to travel without the School tracksuit but the overall appearance of the sports uniform must be one of neatness. Footwear must be worn, unless otherwise instructed by the supervising staff.

### **Sports Uniforms for Matches**

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The following dress will be worn while playing School sport:

#### **Athletics**

*House Athletics:* Plain House polo (light blue, dark blue, red, gold, brown, light green, orange and dark green). Navy PE shorts.

*School Athletics team:* School Athletics singlet, navy blue athletic shorts and School Sports team shirt.

### **Summer Sport Uniform**

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#### ***Basketball***

School Athletics singlet, navy PE shorts, white sports socks and the correct footwear. (The school provides singlets for matches).

#### ***Cricket***

White shirt, short or long white trousers, white socks, white joggers or cricket boots. Members of the 1st and 2nd XI wear long trousers. School Cricket Cap or white cricket hat

#### ***Rowing***

School polo shirt, navy PE shorts (in Year 8). Rowing zoot suit, School 'V' neck team top, rowing toweling hat (for Years 8 -12) and School long-sleeved white top. (for Years 9-12).

### ***Sailing***

Navy PE shorts, School polo shirt , Gold (Craigie House) rugby jumper (optional).

### ***Swimming***

School racing bathers. School 'V' neck team top if selected in the School Team, rash top (optional).

### ***Tennis***

School polo shirt, navy PE shorts, sandals and white sports socks. (1st VIII wear special shirt).

### ***Volleyball***

School polo shirt, navy PE shorts, sandals and white sports socks. (1st VIII wear special shirt).

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## **Winter Sport Uniform**

### ***Badminton***

School polo shirt, navy PE shorts, sandals and white sports socks. (The 1st IX wear a special shirt).

### ***Cross-Country***

School Athletics singlet, navy PE shorts. (1st XV wear a special shirt).

### ***Football***

Navy 'CCGS' football shorts, longwinter football socks, School football jumper (blue with yellow yoke) and football boots. (Members of the 1st XVIII are provided with a special jumper).

NB. A school training jumper (available from the clothing exchange) or other team top is required for training session).

### ***Hockey***

Navy PE shorts, School polo shirt and football socks. (The 1st XI wear a special shirt).

### ***Rugby***

School rugby jumper, navy blue rugby shorts, and School football socks. (The 1st XV wear a special jumper).

### ***Soccer***

School polo shirt, navy PE shorts and football socks. (The 1st XI wear a special shirt).
