Conducted by MMG Education

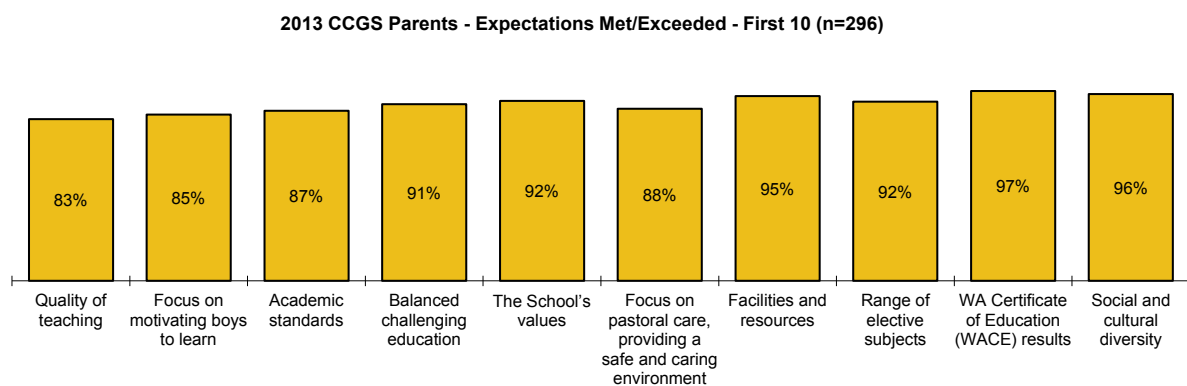

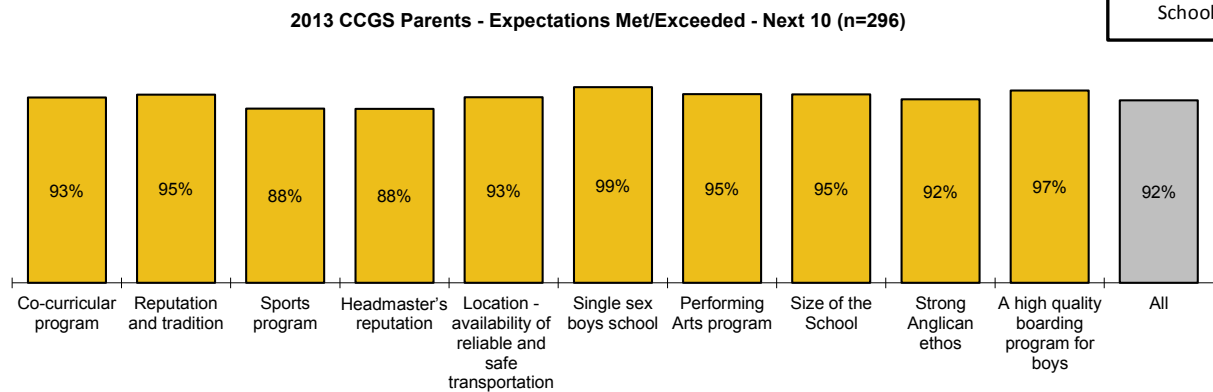
The chart below shows the percentage of parents who noted their expectations had been met/exceeded on each key area.
