



When preparing your will or submitting amendments we recommend you seek professional advice or the assistance of a solicitor. Below is the suggested wording to include if you intend to leave a gift to Christ Church Grammar School;

'I (insert name here) bequeath to Christ Church Grammar School ABN 55 063 453 350 for its general purposes (or name a specific purpose, such as the Old Boys' Association Scholarship Trust, The Indigenous Scholarship Fund or the Building Fund – please call us to discuss)

[Choose and insert the appropriate statement from the list below]

1. *the whole of my estate*
2. *(insert number) percentage of my estate*
3. *the residual of my estate*
4. *the amount of \$ (insert the value of your gift in cash)*
5. *my (insert name of asset)*

free of all duties, and the receipt of the Secretary or other authorised officer for the time being shall be a complete and sufficient discharge for the Executor(s).'

If you already have a will, you may like to add a codicil to include the School — a simple and inexpensive process. A codicil is an addition, in a separate document, to an earlier will. It has to meet the formal requirements of a will and should refer to the original will and the date it was made.
