<b>Friday 16 June</b> <b>5.00pm AEST</b>	<b>Last date</b> for registrations for UMAT with a late fee of \$65. No further registrations after this date
<b>Monday 17 July</b>	2017 ATAR course examinations timetable available
<b>Friday 21 July</b>	<b>Last date</b> for withdrawal from ATAR courses with practical examination components

<b>Friday 8 September</b>	Candidates' personalised timetables for the 2017 practical and written ATAR examinations available online. To log on, they will need their SCSA student number and other personal identification information

<b>23 September to 1 October (Saturday, Sunday and the public holiday included)</b>	ATAR practical examinations for Aviation, Dance, Drama, Music and Physical Education Studies – <b>candidates must be available throughout this period</b>
<b>14, 15 October</b>	ATAR practical examinations for Chinese: Second Language
<b>14, 15 October</b>	ATAR practical examination for Japanese: Second Language
<b>13 October to 29 October (Saturday, Sunday and public holiday included)</b>	ATAR practical examinations for English as an Additional Language or Dialect, French
<b>Wednesday 1 November</b>	Start of ATAR written examinations
<b>Wednesday 22 November</b>	Scheduled finish of ATAR written examinations (date may be earlier, but not later, depending on examination timetabling)
<b>2018 Early January</b>	SCSA issues Western Australian Certificate of Education, course reports and Western Australian Statement of Student Achievement.
