

ATHLETICS & POST WINTER SEASON PROGRAM NOTICE

Parents of Year 7, 8 & 9 boys

Sport and Activities: Weeks 6 -10

Please be aware that in Term 3, weeks 6 - 10, there will be a modified schedule around sports training and Friday games.

Over this period the school has moved into the Athletics season. The House Teams carnival is on Friday 25 August for all senior boys. Details have been distributed to boys by Heads of House. The carnival runs from 1.45 to 5.00pm at either Mt Claremont (AFL Football and Handball) or St John's Wood (Rugby and Soccer) and boys will be bused to and from the venues. Boys can be collected from venues by parents as for normal Friday sporting fixtures.

Specific boys will be identified and involved in the PSA Athletics program which concludes with the PSA Inters Athletics on Friday 8 September at the WA Athletics Stadium. For boys outside this program there will be no Wednesday training for the remainder of Term 3.

Boys who are involved in Athletics will attend the Quadrangular Athletics on Friday 1 September and the Inters Athletics on Friday 8 September respectively. Specific details about these two events will be discussed with competing athletes by the athletics coaching staff. All other Year 7, 8 & 9 boys will be involved in normal classes then special Friday afternoon programs based at the Claremont Campus from 1.20 to 3.00pm. The details of these respective programs will be provided to the boys closer to the specific dates. Boys will continue to wear their CCGS PE uniform to school on these days even though they will not be involved in sport.

On Friday 15 September between 1.20 to 3.30pm all Year 7, 8 & 9 boys will be involved in practice games/organisation for summer codes in Term 4. Details of the program for the sport practice session on this afternoon will be made available at the start of Week 9 on the website and communicated to boys directly through their House.
