Dear Parents

As part of the exciting Year 5 program, the boys in this cohort will be experiencing four days of sailing on the Swan River. They will be taught a basic course, with a possible extension to aspects of higher levels.

The sailing experience for each Year 5 class is outlined below:

5CT - Monday 30 October to Thursday 2 November

5JG - Monday 6 November to Thursday 9 November

5NH - Monday 13 November to Thursday 16 November

5JM - Monday 20 November to Thursday 23 November

All boys are to meet at the Freshwater Bay Yacht Club (1 Hobbs Place, Peppermint Grove) no later than 8.25am, in time to begin their lessons at 8.30am. If for some reason you are unable to drop your son at the yacht club, please deliver him to school at the normal time (8.10am) and the school bus will depart at 8.15am and take him to the yacht club.

What to wear / what to bring:

- 1. Boardies, t-shirt, old runners, a hat, sunscreen and water bottle.
- 2. At the conclusion of the lesson the boys will change into their normal sport uniform, which they can wear for the rest of the school day.
- 3. Regular fruit break items and a packed lunch. The boys will not be able to order their lunch on the four days they are committed to sailing.

At the conclusion of the morning's activities the boys will be bussed back to school in time for their afternoon classes. After school pick up is at the regular time.

Some days may be cool so a spray jacket may be worn.
