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**POSITION CONTEXT:**

Christ Church Grammar School is an Anglican day and boarding school for boys from Pre-School to Year 12. Located in Perth, Western Australia, the School overlooks the Swan River at Freshwater Bay in Claremont. Enrolments are comprehensive and at present are approximately 1650 students. This includes 120 boarders. The School consists of the LW Parry Preparatory School (PP to 6) and the Senior School (Years 7 to 12).

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**LINE MANAGEMENT:**

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**WORKING RELATIONSHIPS:**

The Drama Department and the Midnite Youth Theatre Company has 5 staff members.

- Contribute positively and collaboratively to the development of Drama in the curriculum.
- Contribute positively and collaboratively to the development and administration of co-curricular Drama.
- The ability to bring creativity and freshness to the direction of productions.
- The Arts culture at Christ Church Grammar School is particularly positive. The Music and Art Departments produce outstanding work and results and often work in close collaboration with the Drama Department. The role of the successful applicant will be to support and develop these relationships.
- An ability to contribute to the co-curricular programs of the School.

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**TEACHING DUTIES:**

- Teaching Drama classes equivalent to 0.76 FTE teaching time.
