

Consent2Go

Getting started

All current parents will receive a personalised email with a link to commence the process of uploading their son's current health records. All information is stored within Australia in a Tier 1 environment, complying with Australian privacy requirements.

You will be required to provide information relating to:

- Parent information/Emergency contacts
- Care details
- Medical information
- Confirmation

Once you have completed this process, the real advantages and time savings occur. Ongoing medical updates, and the provision of permission to attend camps and excursions, will be user-friendly and efficient and the new system will completely remove the existing paper-based forms that have been received to date.

Tips before starting the process

There are a number of things that will assist in easy completion of the form:

- Have your Medicare card available
- Know your current doctor's practice name, address and phone number
- Know your private health insurer, policy type and number
- Have a copy of your son's medical condition action plan ready to upload (if applicable)
- Have a copy of your child's vaccination records ready to upload. If your child is an Australian citizen, you will need to obtain a copy of his Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) history statement (it will be beneficial if you have already established a My Gov profile).

Your child's current Vaccination Status Certificate

As part of the amendments to the School Education Regulations, schools will be required to identify an Australian student's vaccination status by sighting the child's current AIR history statement. From 1 January 2019, schools will be required to identify if a student is up to date with their vaccinations and for this information to be included on a school's enrolment register. This information will be disclosed to relevant government authorities as required.

If your child is over 14 years old, your child will need their own myGov account.

FAQs

Q: I received an email advising me that I would soon be receiving a link to Consent2Go but I am yet to receive it, what should I do?

A: Check your Junk email box to see if the email has transferred to your junk /spam email folder. If this has happened, you may want to click 'Not Junk' or add the email address <u>reply@ccgs.wa.edu.au</u> to your Safe senders list.

Q: Where are the data servers located? How is this information stored?

A: For Australian schools, data is stored within Australia in a Tier 1 environment, where all handling of personal information for individuals complies with the Australian Privacy Act 1988.

Q: Is Consent2Go owned by Christ Church Grammar School or a private company?

A: Consent2Go is a private company and is the School's agent for collecting your son's health information.

Q: Consent2Go will not proceed to the next screen

A: Please look for any red icons Swith a cross displayed. This will indicate a compulsory field that must be answered before you can proceed to the next screen.



Q: Can the School provide me with a paper copy of the form as I do not wish for my child's health records to be maintained online?

A: To ensure your child's health records are current, Christ Church Grammar School will regularly require parents/guardians to update their child's health details on Consent2Go. To minimise risk, the School does not maintain health records in any other format.

Q: What happens if I change my email address?

A: Please contact the School and provide your new email address.

Q: Where do I download the app?

A: There is no Smartphone app available for Consent2Go. The platform can be accessed via any web browser.

Q: How much do I pay to use Consent2Go?

A: The Consent2Go system is free for parents. The School pays an annual fee to use Consent2Go.
