





#### **ATAR** examinations

- Must attend and make a genuine attempt
- Some exams held at other schools





- Derived from the Tertiary Entrance Aggregate (TEA)
- TEA = sum of best 4 scaled scores
  - + 10% of a Language Other Than English
  - + 10% of Maths Methods and Maths Specialist
- Maximum TEA = 430
