MEDIA STATEMENT: Christ Church Grammar School 2019 Year 12 ATAR Award Winners

Today, the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA) have released the exhibition and award winners for this year's ATAR examinations. Christ Church Grammar School students once again feature prominently amongst the award winners in 2019.

Six Christ Church students have achieved a General Exhibition, awarded to the top 50 students with the highest WACE award scores based on the average of five equated examination scores in ATAR courses with at least two from each of the Humanities/Social Sciences list and the Mathematics/Science list. These students are: **George Schulz, Robert Lee, William Thomas, Edward Elias, Luke Martino** and **David Lind**.

Christ Church also achieved two Subject Exhibitions, awarded to the top student obtaining the highest examination mark in an ATAR course:
