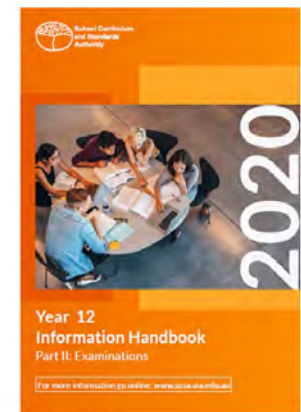

ATAR examinations

ATAR course **written** examinations

- Arrive about 30 minutes prior to examination starting time – no entry if over 30 minutes late
- **Must attend and make a genuine attempt**
- Some exams held at other schools
