Early Risers

This program is designed to provide care for boys/families who need to start the school day early. Based in the Preparatory School Library, boys will engage with resources such as books, games and drawing.

Days and hours of operation

Monday to Friday
7.00am to 8.10am

Daily program

- 7.00am Library open for boys: parents to drop the boys off at the library and provide staff with attendance card to stamp
Boys are able to read, draw, do homework, play board games or chess
- 7.20am Boys provided light breakfast (cereal or toast and fruit) and hot chocolate
- 7.30am Indoor activities or play at the school playground
- 8.00am Boys to pack away activities and clean area
- 8.10am Boys are walked to their classrooms

Age group

The Early Risers Program caters to boys from Kindergarten to Year 6.

Staffing

The program is run by current Christ Church Grammar School staff.

Fees* per day

- Single ticket \$15.00
- 5 tickets \$75.00
- 10 tickets \$135.00

Tickets can be purchased at the Preparatory School Reception during school hours.
Tickets will need to be presented to the staff member on the day of attendance.

* There is no child care support available.

* Credit card fees apply — 0.65% for Visa and Mastercard and 0.95% for AMEX.

Confirming attendance

Parents will need to inform the school via email at kmorcom@ccgs.wa.edu.au by **6.00pm the night before** to confirm their son's attendance. If parents know in advance when their son will be attending the program, they can notify the School via the same email address of the dates of care.
