



Introduction

Outdoor Education and participation in the program at Koorungal Outdoor Education Centre is seen as a significant and compulsory part of a Christ Church student's education. Unfortunately this year has seen significant disruptions to school programs due to COVID 19, in particular during Terms 1 and 2. In the main we have tried to ensure that aspects of all school programs have been provided in some form to ensure awareness and skill development. In this regard, the activities and challenges of Year 7 Koorungal visit are designed to promote and enhanced awareness of self, working with others, the environment and assist students in the orientation to their House as part of a sequential outdoor education program. Whilst a shortened version of our normal camp program we believe it will provide a valuable base for the boys' future outdoor education experiences.

Each Year 7 outdoor education experience will be for one day, with boys travelling to Koorungal in house groups. The boys will be involved in a variety of activities including, environmental awareness, orienteering, canoeing and abseiling/rock climbing.
