



Prestigious academic award goes to Christ Church Grammar School student

Josh Green is WA's top student.

The Christ Church Grammar School graduate has been awarded the Beazley Medal for excelling academically across five courses, including two each from the humanities, and maths and sciences.

He was awarded:

- General Exhibition, recognising outstanding academic achievement in Year 12 ATAR courses with examinations (fifty highest WACE award scores)
- Subject Exhibition: Mathematics Methods
- Subject Certificates of Excellence: Literature, Mathematics Methods, Modern History
- Certificate of Distinction

The Shenton Park teen also attained the highest-possible Australian Tertiary Admission Rank of 99.95, which is based on a student's four best subjects.

He is currently relaxing in Perth and considering his options. Josh said he was continually motivated by his teachers and peers to achieve his personal best and felt that by balancing study and downtime he was able to maintain a focus on his academics throughout the year.

He is interested in studying medicine or physics with the scales tilting towards physics at this stage.
