

Little Queenslea Drive (LQD)

You son will soon be taking part in a two-day and one-night learning experience on campus known as Little Queenslea Drive (LQD). Little Queenslea Drive will be the first overnight learning experience for Preparatory School students and there will be a strong emphasis on the boys having a positive experience away from home. This will be achieved through a 'gentle' introduction to the program with a focus on socialisation between the boys and staff on an informal basis.

Each Year 4 class will participate in LQD

Boys will be accompanied by Christ Church Grammar School staff over the course of the two days. In the event of an emergency we will contact you directly. Please ensure your contact and son's medical details are current in Consent2Go.

Sleeping arrangements and showers

Students and adults will be sleeping in the boarding residence used for the Year 9, On Queenslea Drive program. The facilities are separate from the current boarders and boys will have their own dedicated space. Shower facilities are available for students.

Meals

- Your son will need to bring his recess and a packed lunch for day one
- LQD provides afternoon tea, an evening meal and meals for day two
- Please speak to your class teacher about any dietary concerns and ensure <u>Consent2Go</u> is current

Things to bring

Please ensure that your son brings the following:

- Wear PE uniform on the day of excursion and pack another PE uniform for the following day
- Bring your own pillow and sleeping bag (the School provides a camp mattress)
- Toiletries and pyjamas
- Two pairs of underwear and two pairs of CCGS sports socks
- 1L drink bottle
- School hat
- Warm clothes
- Roll-on insect repellent
- Enclosed footwear (joggers)
- Enclosed footwear that can get wet at the river
- Thongs for the shower
- CCGS bathers, rashie and a small towel

Packing

All items can be packed in a small bag. The boys are required to carry their own bag so
please send them with a small bag or backpack, which they are able to carry
themselves

What is prohibited during the program:

• Mobile phones, torches, smart watch, iPods, electronic games, sweets and money are **prohibited during the program**

• In the case of an emergency, staff will contact the parents

Medications

• If your son is on any prescribed medication/s, please send them with him in a labelled container and inform the class teacher. Ensure all contact details and any medical conditions and medications are updated on Consent2Go
