Christ Church Grammar School is committed to listening to the views and expectations from key stakeholders and commissions independent surveys to provide performance feedback on a wide range of related education topics.

The feedback from these surveys greatly assists the School with both its operational and strategic planning and its determination to continually improve the educational experience offered to the students.

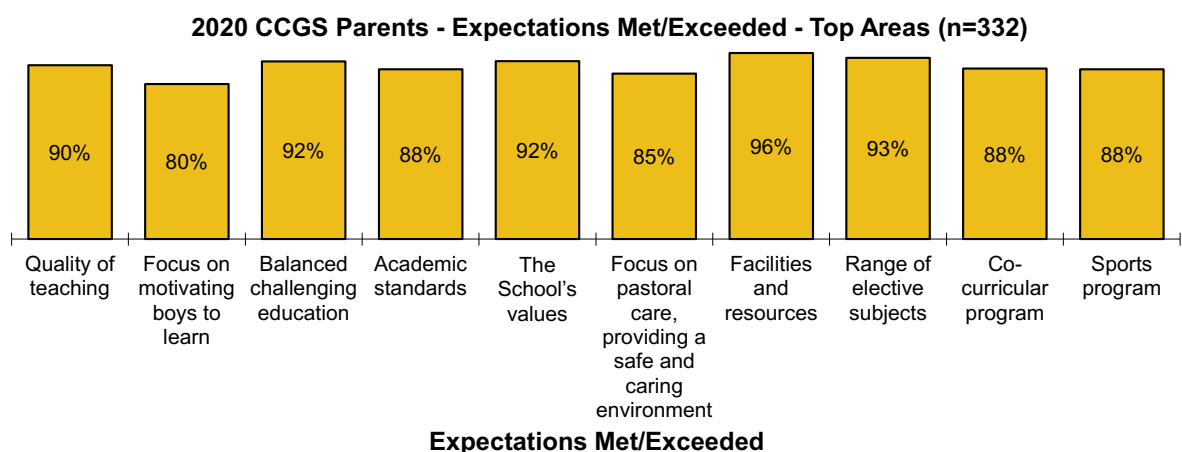
In 2020, 332 parents and 445 students from selected year groups participated in surveys and provided views on such areas as academic performance, pastoral care, Christian education, co-curricular, sport, communications, reputation and facilities.

Parents

A selection of the parents' top level findings are detailed below, ranked in order of the importance the parents placed on reasons for choosing a school for their son:

The top five areas are noted below:

- 90% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the quality of teaching
- 80% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the focus on motivating boys to learn
- 92% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to a balanced challenging education
- 88% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to academic standards
- 92% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the School's values



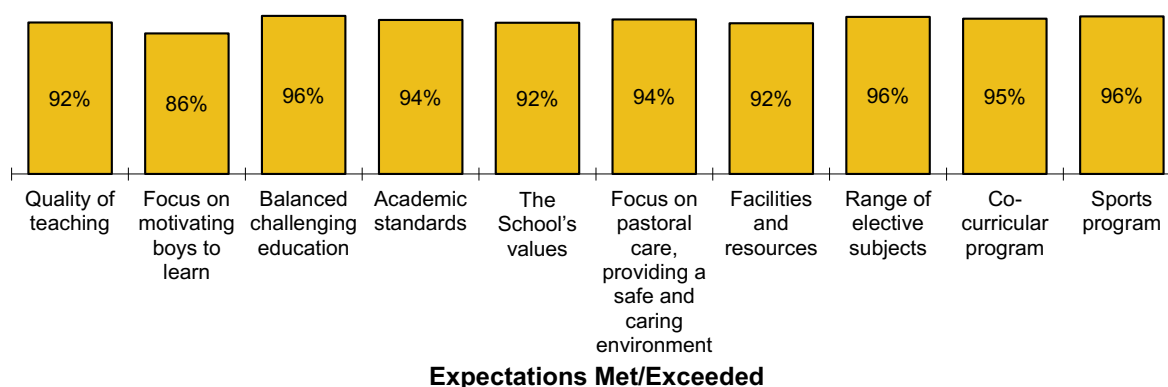
Students

A selection of the students' top level findings are detailed below; ranked in order of the importance the parents placed on reasons for choosing a school:

The top five areas are noted below:

- 92% of students noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the quality of teaching
- 86% of students noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the focus on motivating boys to learn
- 96% of students noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to a balanced challenging education
- 94% of students noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to academic standards
- 92% of students noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the School's values
