

Outdoor Education at Christ Church



Personal challenge, by choice



A Nine Day Camp Program providing opportunities to:

- Develop resilience
- Experience leadership
- Be challenged
- Take healthy risks
- Have direct consequences for their actions
- Experience community living
- Gain an appreciation of the natural environment





Activities Include

- Ropes course
- Rogaine
- 5 day expedition
- Community service
- A solo experience





Ropes Course

- Students work in groups of three
- Two 'belay' while one climbs
- Promotes teamwork and trust
- Provides a high level of 'perceived' challenge
- Excellent tool for developing confidence and communication





Rogaine

- 7 hour orienteering challenge
- Students are in groups of 4 chosen at random
- Provides opportunities for independence, teamwork and responsibility
- Practice their navigation skills for the expedition
- Check points / radios / trackers





Five day expedition

Three days of bushwalking

- Leadership
- Challenge
- Responsibility
- Organisational skills
- A 'Venture' like experience

Two days of canoe touring

- Leadership
- Challenge

- An important part of the outdoor program
- Helps with reflection and to process the experience
- Collected in a folder and returned at graduation





Community service

- 'Putting something back'
- Fencing
- Garden work
- Track maintenance
- Kooringal improvements





Solo - 15 hours alone

- A very different challenge and experience no external influences
- Culmination of the Year 9 Camp experience
- A chance to put into practice all they have learnt
- Time to reflect and think about what has been achieved
- Some space after eight intensive days living together
- A 'peak' experience to end the camp



Solo

- Challenge by choice
- Each student given a specific camp site marked by a witches hat and reflective tape
- Self sufficient with food, water, shelter and clothes
- Checked at sun down night time checks.
- Levels of challenge
- No one 'fails' solo




Equipment
