



## Student presentation

1. Boys are expected to ensure that their dress and appearance bring credit to the School and themselves.
2. The School has a formal uniform, a separate uniform for summer as well as sport and physical education (PE) uniforms. These are listed below:
  - The formal uniform is also the winter School uniform. Boys are required to wear their blazers to and from school whenever the formal uniform is worn. Boys may wear the school pullover, however, it should be worn with blazer and not instead of. Blazers may be taken off at school and should be hung on the special hook located in each boy's personal locker.
  - At other times boys are expected to wear the appropriate school uniform whilst travelling to and from school and for all school functions unless otherwise informed.

## Uniform details

### Formal Uniform (and Winter Uniform)

Blazer (with House braid Years 7-12)  
College grey trousers with black school belt  
School pullover (jumper)  
White shirt with Tie (or Year 12 tie)  
Black shoes\* with navy School socks

### Summer Uniform:

Navy shorts  
Striped shirt  
School pullover (jumper)  
Black shoes\* with navy School socks

*\* These must be polishable lace-up black shoes (not boots or sport shoes).*

### Sport & Physical Education (PE)

Tracksuit (top and pants)  
Poly/cotton shirt (gold with navy stripe, collar, crest)  
Navy PE shorts  
White sport socks  
House polo shirt  
School racing bathers  
Sports shoes  
Navy school cap or hat  
Rash top for aquatics

## Sports Uniform (cont.)

1. The school polo shirt is the playing top for PE.
2. Hats: Wide-brimmed navy hats with the School Crest are available at the Uniform shop and are to be the only hats worn by boys at the school. Hats are to be worn at all outdoor sports and PE classes.
3. Sunscreen lotion: boys are encouraged to bring their own sunscreen lotion. However, sunscreen lotion is available in the PE centre and is included in the kits for summer games.

## Sports uniform when travelling

When travelling to or from training or matches boys must wear either the School uniform or the School tracksuit. During summer, boys may be permitted to travel without the School tracksuit but the overall appearance of the sports uniform must be one of neatness. Footwear must be worn, unless otherwise instructed by the supervising staff.

## After school sports training

- All boys are expected to wear their match or House sports uniform and the correct footwear.
- When travelling to or from training, boys must wear either the appropriate sports uniform, school uniform or school tracksuit top.
- The school tracksuit jacket may be worn when travelling to matches and as the warm-up and cool-down top. It may also be used in the same way on training days but is NOT a training or in competition.

During summer, boys may be permitted to travel without the school tracksuit but the overall appearance of the sports uniform must be one of neatness. Footwear must be worn, unless otherwise instructed by the supervising staff.

## Inter-school matches

The following specific uniforms are to be worn whilst playing inter-school sport:

### **Athletics**

*House Athletics:* Plain House polo with Navy PE shorts.

*School Athletics team:* School Athletics singlet, navy blue athletic shorts and School Sports team shirt.

## Summer sports

### ***Basketball***

School athletics singlet, navy PE shorts, white sports socks and the correct footwear. (The school provides numbered singlets for matches).

### ***Cricket***

White shirt, long white trousers, white socks, white joggers or cricket boots. Members of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> XI wear long trousers and a special shirt with a white cricket hat.

### ***Rowing***

School polo shirt, navy PE shorts (in Year 8). Rowing zoot suit, white tee School 'V' neck team top, rowing toweling hat (for Years 8 -12).

### ***Sailing***

Navy PE shorts, school polo shirt, school rash top.

### ***Swimming***

School racing bathers. School 'V' neck team top if selected in the school team, rash top (optional)

### ***Tennis***

Tennis polo, navy PE shorts, sport shoes and white sport socks (1<sup>st</sup> VIII wear special shirt).

### ***Volleyball***

Volleyball polo, navy PE shorts, sport shoes and white sport socks (1<sup>st</sup> VIII wear special shirt).

## Winter sports

### ***Badminton***

Badminton polo, navy PE shorts, sport shoes and white sports socks (1<sup>st</sup> IX wear a special shirt).

### ***Cross-Country***

Cross country singlet, navy athletic shorts. (1<sup>st</sup> XV wear a special shirt).

### ***Football***

Navy CCGS football shorts, football socks, football jumper (blue with yellow yoke) and football boots. (1<sup>st</sup> XVIII are provided with a special jumper).

### ***Hockey***

Navy PE shorts, hockey polo and football socks. (The 1<sup>st</sup> XI wear a special shirt).

### ***Rugby***

Years 5-9 school rugby jumper; Years 10-12 senior rugby top; navy blue rugby shorts and football socks. (The 1<sup>st</sup> XV wear a special jumper).

### ***Soccer***

Soccer polo, navy PE shorts and football socks. (The 1<sup>st</sup> XI wear a special shirt).

### ***Surf Life Saving***

School Gold Polo, blue school shorts, school bathers (wet suit instruction from TIC)

<b>WINTER/FORMAL UNIFORM</b>	School Blazer (and House ID Ribbon) to be worn to and from School every day. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. The School jumper may be worn under the blazer but not as an outer garment while traveling to and from School.</li> <li>ii. While at School the blazer may be removed and hung in the locker.</li> <li>iii. After sport training the School tracksuit may be worn home, with the blazer in the School bag.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dirty and crumpled blazer.</li> <li>• Arriving at school or leaving the School while not wearing the blazer.</li> <li>• Wearing the School tracksuit top instead of a jumper or blazer.</li> </ul>
	White shirt and School tie. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. The top shirt button must be fastened.</li> <li>ii. The tie is to be done up.</li> <li>iii. Shirt is to be tucked into the trousers.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shirt without buttons.</li> <li>• Dirty or crumpled shirt.</li> <li>• Coloured t-shirt worn under the shirt.</li> <li>• Shirt buttons not fastened.</li> <li>• Shirt tails outside of the trousers (untucked shirt).</li> </ul>

<b>SUMMER UNIFORM</b>	School white and navy striped shirt. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Shirt is to be tucked into the shorts.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shirt without buttons.</li> <li>• Dirty or crumpled shirt.</li> <li>• Coloured t-shirt worn under the shirt.</li> <li>• Shirt buttons not fastened.</li> <li>• Shirt tails outside of the trousers (untucked shirt).</li> </ul>
	School navy shorts.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dirty or torn shorts.</li> </ul>
<b>AT ALL TIMES</b>	School navy pullover.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dirty or torn pullover.</li> <li>• Sleeves stretched over the hands.</li> </ul>
	School socks (navy with gold stripe).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sport socks of any kind.</li> <li>• Multi-coloured casual socks.</li> <li>• Black socks.</li> </ul>
	Polished black leather shoes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boots, skate shoes or joggers.</li> <li>• Shoes that are not polished.</li> <li>• Shoes without laces, with torn, incomplete, or untied laces.</li> <li>• Laces other than black.</li> </ul>
	Jewellery is not to be worn. No piercings, rings, jewellery, or wristbands are to be worn. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. This applies to any boy traveling to and from School, in School uniform, on a School activity, or whenever the boy is in the School's care unless exempted by the Deputy Principal/Head of Senior School.</li> <li>ii. Watches, important religious and medical symbols are acceptable.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rings on fingers, bangles, bracelets, or necklaces.</li> <li>• Rings, studs, or sleepers including those through ears or other body parts.</li> </ul>
	<b>SHAVING</b> Boys should always be clean shaven with sideburns that finish midpoint of ear.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Moustaches.</li> <li>• Sideburns past the midpoint of ear.</li> </ul>
	<b>HAIR</b> In keeping with the statement on dress and appearance, hair styles should be clean, tidy, and not grown or groomed in an extreme or exaggerated fashion. Hair should be regularly cut, kept neat and above the eyebrows, ears, and shirt collar. It must be of natural colour, worn off the face and should not be able to obstruct sight. Hair should be cut no shorter than a number 3 cut, nor have significant contrast in length. Hair should not be tucked behind the ears nor need to be tied back in any way to play sport ( <b>see following page for an illustration of hair expectations</b> ).
