Christ Church - Top performing Western Australian boys' school

Today, the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA) have released student achievement data for Year 12 students in the 2021 cohort.

Christ Church was placed in the group of top performing schools in **21** Year 12 courses. This places Christ Church as the **top performing boys' school** and second in terms of the number of top performing courses achieved by schools. The courses are:
