

Sunset Club

This club is designed to support families who need to extend the school day. Based in the Preparatory School Multi-Purpose Room, boys will engage in a fun program every afternoon.

Days and hours of operation

Monday to Friday
2.45pm to 6.00pm

Daily program

- 2.45pm Boys from Pre-Primary, Years 1 and 2 are collected from classrooms and walked to the club room.
- 3.10pm Boys from Years 3 to 6 arrive at Preparatory School Multi-Purpose Room.
- 3.15pm Boys participate in quiet indoor activities such as reading, drawing or homework.
- 3.40pm Boys provided with afternoon tea.
- 3.50pm Boys participate in supervised/organised outdoor play such as nature playground activities, small team games, group stations.
- 4.50pm Boys return to Multi-Purpose Room for organised indoor activities such as arts and crafts, construction, board games and imagination play.
- 6.00pm Conclusion of Sunset Club. Boys can be collected from the Multi-Purpose Room at any time.

The Sunset Club caters to boys from Pre-Primary to Year 6.
