

Christ Church students awarded prestigious scholarships

Graduating Christ Church Grammar School students Nicholas Ng and Grant Hogarth have been awarded the prestigious Winthrop and Fogarty Scholarships respectively for their exemplary academic results.

The University of Western Australia's (UWA) Fogarty Foundation Scholarship Program is one of Australia's premier scholarship programs, offered as part of a joint venture between the Fogarty Foundation and UWA, investing in the future leaders of Western Australia.

Just 10 scholarships are offered for Year 12 high school students from WA with each scholarship valued at \$10,000 per annum.

The UWA Winthrop Scholarship is awarded to eligible high-achieving Year 12 students to encourage and assist them to commence and undertake undergraduate studies at UWA, valued at \$20,000.00.

In addition, Year 12 student Jack Cooper was awarded a position at Colorado Mesa University in the USA to play Lacrosse and study Exercise Physiology.

Christ Church Grammar School Principal Alan Jones said he was immensely proud of the boys' achievements.
