Christ Church Grammar School bring Olympian Eddie Ockenden to Bunbury

Christ Church Grammar School is bringing Olympian Eddie Ockenden to Bunbury for a free community hockey clinic.

The School is offering hockey enthusiasts aged 10 to 18 in the South West a series of hockey skill sessions, and friendly matches with Eddie and a team of hockey players.

Eddie is a four-time Olympian, as well as a recipient of multiple World Cup gold medals.

Among many of his awards is his attainment of International Youth Player of the Year 2008, and within the Australian side as three-time Kookaburras' Player of the Year.

Most recently, Eddie co-captained the Kookaburras, taking out the gold medal during the 2022 Birmingham Commonwealth Games.

The day will be broken into three sessions:

1. Children up to school Year 6 - 9.00am to 9.50am
2. Children in school Years 7 and 8 - 10.00am to 10.50am
3. Children in school Years Year 9 to 12 - 11.00am to 11.50am

Each group will be supervised by a skilled hockey player, and participants are both boys and girls.

The event will include a sausage sizzle, and an opportunity to find out more about the School's unique boarding program.
