

Christ Church Grammar School harnessing Artificial Intelligence to enhance education

In the wake of the recent launch of the artificial intelligence (AI) chatbot, ChatGPT, schools around the country have taken different approaches to this new technology.

While public schools in states, including Western Australia, have banned student access to ChatGPT, Christ Church Grammar School is not banning it, but embracing it.

At Christ Church, our approach to ChatGPT is to show students how to harness the technology to assist in their leaning.

It is still early days for this technology, but we are confident that it will be positive for both student learning and will also enhance teaching.

Our teachers have already begun experimenting with ChatGPT and will continue to receive training to effectively integrate Artificial Intelligence technology into our pedagogy and teaching methods.

The School is also educating students and the community on the integration of AI to learning and teaching.

Christ Church Grammar School Principal Alan Jones said that Christ Church believes in educating our students on technology, rather than prohibiting its use.

"Our focus is to help them understand how ChatGPT can be used for the benefit of their learning experience, while also learning about the consequences of inappropriate use," he said.

"We believe that AI has the potential to address challenges in education and innovate teaching and learning practices. Currently our action is to work with the students whilst also making changes to assessment protocols."

"While some universities have updated their academic integrity policies in response to ChatGPT, we remain confident that technology will evolve to uphold academic integrity."

The School has invited parents to an information session on Thursday 9 February aimed at engaging in positive dialogue about the role of AI in education and how it can be leveraged for the benefit of all.
