

These practical guidelines have been compiled to assist parents and boys in the interpretation of the expectations at Christ Church Grammar School (as at 20 April 2023)

WINTER/FORMAL UNIFORM	School blazer (and House ID ribbon) to be worn to and from the School every day: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The School jumper may be worn under the blazer but not as an outer garment while travelling to and from school While at school the blazer may be removed and hung in the locker After sport training the school tracksuit may be worn home, with the blazer in the school bag 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dirty and crumpled blazer Arriving or leaving the School while not wearing the blazer Wearing the school tracksuit top instead of a jumper or blazer
	White shirt and school tie <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The top shirt button must be fastened The tie is to be done up 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirt without buttons Dirty shirt Coloured t-shirt worn under the shirt Shirt buttons not fastened Shirt tail outside the trousers
	School grey trousers with a black belt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trousers without a belt Trousers of a different shade of grey Dirty trousers
SUMMER UNIFORM	School white and navy striped shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirt without buttons Dirty shirt Coloured t-shirt worn under the shirt Shirt buttons not fastened Shirt tail outside the trousers
	School navy shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dirty shorts
AT ALL TIMES	School navy pullover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dirty or torn pullover Sleeves stretched over the hands
	School socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sport socks of any kind Multi-coloured casual socks
	Polished black leather shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Boots, skate shoes, joggers Shoes that are not polished Shoes without laces, with torn, incomplete or untied laces Laces other than black
	Make-up of any type is not to be worn when in school uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eyeline and foundation cannot be worn. Nails on hands and toes cannot be coloured with nail polish or paint
	Jewellery is not to be worn. No piercings, rings, jewellery or wristbands are to be worn: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> This applies to any boy travelling to and from school, in school uniform, on a school activity, or whenever the boy is in the School's care unless exempted by the Deputy Principal Watches, important religious and medical symbols are acceptable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rings on fingers, bangles, bracelets or necklaces Rings, studs or sleepers including those through ears or other body parts
	HAIR In keeping with the statement on dress and appearance, hairstyles should be tidy and not grown or groomed in an extreme or exaggerated fashion. Hair should be regularly cut, kept neat and above the shirt collar. It must be their natural colour and not dyed or coloured, worn off the face and should not be able to obstruct sight. Hair should be cut no shorter than a number 3 cut, nor have significant contrast in length. Hair should not be tucked behind the ears nor need to be tied back in any way in order to play sport. Boys should be clean shaven at all times.	

Expectations for hair

Hair needs to be regularly washed, be brushed or combed in presentation. Neat and tidy.

Fringe cannot hang in front of eyebrows.

Face needs to be clean shaven at all times with no stubble or moustache.

Fringe cannot be hooked behind ears.

Overall length must be '3' or above.

Hairstyles cannot be extreme or exaggerated. Eg. mullets or shaved sections.

Hair cannot be excessively thick and large in appearance.

Fringe cannot fall in front of eyes at any time. Hair should not be able to obstruct sight at any time.

Hair needs to be above the collar at all times.

Hair on side cannot be shaved less than a '3'. Hair on the side must be graduated with the rest of the hair with no line cuts on the side. No significant contrast in length overall.

Hair must be natural in colour.

Sideburns cannot be longer than the middle of the ear.
