ACSMF 2023 Billeting Request

We are very excited to be hosting the 22nd Australian Combined Schools Music Festival at Methodist Ladies' College along with our partner schools, Christ Church Grammar School, John XXIII College and Scotch College.

As host schools we are responsible for housing and looking after students who are travelling to Western Australia for the festival. We hope to be able to make this a memorable and very special time for everyone involved.

What's involved with being a host family:

Provide accommodation, most meals and transport for one or more students during the festival.

- Accommodation will be for 4 nights, Wednesday 28 June to Sunday 2 July 2023.
- It is preferable for students to be hosted in groups of at least 2. However, we realise circumstances may not always permit this and are happy to hear from families who could accommodate a single billet. We are of course delighted if you can host more than 2.
- Students will need to each have a separate bed; however, they can share a room. Fold out/sofa beds or a mattress on the floor is also acceptable. Boys should not be in the same room as girls.
- All students will be required to bring lunch each day during the festival. Festival students will
 not have access to the school canteen during the festival.
- Evening meals would be required on the Wednesday, and Thursday (all festival musicians will be attending a social function on the Friday evening, which will include dinner).
- Saturday evening meal not required as this would be during the time of the concert. However, a very substantial late afternoon tea would be perfect.
- Transport please note that school students cannot drive billeted students. This is particularly important, to comply with our Duty of Care to the visiting students.

Working with Children Card

All adults over the age of 18 need to hold current WWC Clearance (Working with Children). The cost for this application is \$11, as you are classified as volunteers.

If you do not have a current WWCC, you can collect an application form from the music department at your school. Please forward copies of all WWCC's to acsmf@mlc.wa.edu.au.



No other persons over the age of 18 to reside at the house without proof of a current WWCC.
