



Christ Church Grammar School boys raise over \$18,000 for Camp Quality

Christ Church Grammar School Preparatory School boys have raised over \$18,000 for Camp Quality, participating in an annual Lapathon earlier this week.

The Lapathon fundraiser has been a staple of the School calendar since 2013 with all boys from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6 given 20 minutes to run as many laps as they can to raise money for a worthy cause.

Boys find sponsors such as family, friends, and neighbours or raise money themselves to donate. Sponsors can donate a specified amount per lap achieved by the boys or a make one-off donation.

The recipient of the donations, Camp Quality Australian children's cancer charity, Camp Quality will use the money to improve the quality of life for kids facing cancer, and build optimism and resilience towards their cancer experience – through community, education, and a huge dose of fun.

Head of Preparatory School Steven Males said he was proud of the enormous effort the boys had put into raising funds.

"Camp Quality is a charity that is close to the heart of the Christ Church community with current students in the Preparatory School accessing their services," he said.

"With over \$18,000 raised and counting, this event has proven that small steps can make a big difference."

Christ Church Grammar School Principal Alan Jones said the Preparatory School demonstrated the power of community in their fundraising efforts.

"Since 2013 the Lapathon has become an annual tradition of generosity, with boys raising funds for charities that make a real difference in the lives of those who need it," he said.
