

NAPLAN Results 2023

This year's NAPLAN results indicate that the mean scores achieved by Christ Church students across Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 are well above the state and national means in each domain of numeracy, reading, writing, spelling and grammar and punctuation.

When NAPLAN results are used as part of a comprehensive data analysis process which includes school assessment and standardised test results, we are able to ascertain both broad achievement data for entire cohorts as well as track future learning growth for each student.
