### **Class Concerts - Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6 (18 to 21 September)**

Students who currently learn an instrument with an internal or external instrumental tutor can perform in the year level class concerts held in the Chapel or RATFish (Room Above the Fishbowl). Students will need to work with their instrumental tutor to prepare an item with the following parameters:

- One or two pieces per instrument (maximum of two instruments)
- Maximum length of 8 minutes for the entire item
- Students performing in a group/band/ensemble may also perform one solo item
- Any backing tracks used will need to be loaded on your son's iPad
- Piano accompanists are not provided. If your son requires a piano accompanist, this will need to be organised externally.
