Purpose

To provide educational assistance to students and teachers at the Cambodian Children's Fund (CCF) community schools, and deliver one-on-one instruction in the areas of literacy, numeracy, language acquisition and cultural sharing.

Accommodation/Transport

Provided in a safe and modest hotel with facilities for team activities, refection and pool leisure time. A bus hire company will provide transport.

Applications are due by **Friday 22 September 2023** Selection will be based on first-come, first-served basis.





Daily activities - What will we do?

The participants will be:

- Meeting and assisting in the teaching of hundreds of children who may be orphaned, or living in desperate situations on the rubbish dump.
- Giving out meals and assisting with the feeding of the children.
- Assisting with child care.
- Communicating and building conversational English skills amongst the students
- Learning traditional Cambodian dances and performing at a concert.
- Touring the area and CCF schools.
- Tutoring older students in maths, science, English, IT and any subject where they might need assistance.
- Visiting the Killing Fields and learning about the history of the country.
- Visiting the Golden Palace and Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum.
- Meditation at a Buddhist temple
- River cruise along the Mekong River
- Shopping at the markets.
- Making and providing school resources.



Cost

Approximately \$5000 per CCGS student. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 will be due when the trip is confirmed. The schedule for the balance of payment will be advised at the first meeting.

Any substantial surplus from the trip will be refunded to parents after the finalisation of trip expenses. If there is a surplus, parents will be given the option to donate their surplus to the CCF.





Requirements

There are just 24 places available for both Christ Church Grammar School and St Mary's Anglican Girls' School students in Year 11 on this journey. As places are limited, selection will be based on first-come, first served basis.

There will be two compulsory preparation sessions for both students and parents to provide useful information and an opportunity for the group to meet and connect as a team. You will be advised of the dates in 2024.

All participants and their parents will be expected to sign forms accepting the rules of conduct and expectations on the trip.

Parents will need to attend a minimum of two sessions, with their son/daughter, before departure.

Students must attend several extra sessions to create and make teaching aids ready for their visit.

All participants will be required to assist with fundraising efforts.

There will be medical requirements and a recommended visit to a travel doctor in preparation for the trip.
