

# **Year 12 Subject selection 2026**

Students going into Year 12 must choose six subjects comprising:

- one English subject (English or Literature or EALD) from List A
- at least one subject from List B
- three or four more subjects from List A and/or List B

Some subjects may be run at MLC and some may have MLC students enrolled. Parents and students will be advised later in the year if a selected subject is to run at MLC.

### ATAR Pathway (4 or more ATAR Subjects)

- Students must select six timetabled subjects. A Private Study may be one of these six subjects.
- Students wishing to receive an ATAR must complete at least four ATAR courses (this includes sitting and making a genuine attempt in the final ATAR examination).
- Mathematics Applications and Mathematics Methods may both be selected and can both be used in the calculation of an ATAR score.
- Mathematics Applications, Mathematics Methods and Mathematics Specialist may not be selected together.
- Students wishing to pick up an ATAR subject that was not studied in Year 11 must be in contact with the Studies Office **as soon as possible**. Priority is given in the timetabling to students continuing with courses from Year 11 so not all requests may be possible. Students will also need to independently catch up on Year 11 content.
- At CCGS, the following subjects are **not** permitted to be selected in Year 12, if they have not been completed at an ATAR level in Year 11;

#### Non-ATAR Pathway (3 or fewer ATAR subjects)

- Students must select six timetabled subjects, including one English subject and one Mathematics subject.
- Students who completed Careers and Employability General in Year 11 must select a General subject to replace it in Year 12.
- Students can elect, in consultation with the Careers Counsellor, to study a Certificate
  course off-campus in Year 12 if they are studying no more than one ATAR subject. An offcampus Certificate course does not count as one of the six timetabled subjects a student
  must be enrolled in at CCGS.
